

Uganda 2009 Trip Report

Kampala, Uganda, at Christ Global Embassy



The Lord did so many amazing things; it is hard to write a summary! I spent about 2 ½ weeks in Uganda. In Kampala I ministered with Pastors Sam and Jane Kakete of Christ Global Embassy. I preached most days and sometimes twice a day. The main theme was “Those Who are Called”. The Lord had given me the topic before I left but no detailed notes allowed! As I began to preach, the Holy Spirit would anoint me and the story would come to me “on the fly”. We talked about faith (Abraham), prophetic anointing (Elisha), conflict of faith (Ester), overcoming bitterness (Naomi), the making of a warrior (Gideon), and discipleship.

God released His healing power and prophetic words. Some people were saved, some baptized in the Holy Spirit, seven were baptized in water, and others received a healing touch from the Lord. Hands were laid on for the anointing to move in healing and prophetic gifting.

Pastors Sam & Jane and I traveled to Mbarara to minister with Pastor David Turyahebwa at Mbarara Community Church. We spent 2 days in one village, 4 days in Mbarara and one day in a second village. Our first day in Mbarara, we ministered to a dear sister who had been assailed by demonic forces through trauma and witchcraft. God moved mightily and she was completely set free.

I preached about “Receiving the Spirit without Measure”, “Deliverance”, “Healing”, “Gifts of the Spirit”, “Words of Knowledge”, “Sowing and Reaping”, “The Fire and the Glory” and “Who do you say I AM?”. Pastor Sam preached on Evangelism and the call of the church. God moved mightily in the ministry time, saving, healing, delivering and anointing. It was awesome to see what He did.

I also released a word to the pastors from Ezekiel about “The Role of a Shepherd”. Jane had two powerful dreams relating to this teaching. The basic message was for pastors and leaders to be about the Lord’s work of bringing in the sheep and then teaching, healing and discipling them. All Glory to God!
