

Uganda July 2008 Trip Report

I left Malawi, Africa, on July 26th and headed to Johannesburg, South Africa, stepping back into the Western world for 1 day. Then it was on to Kampala, Uganda, and ministering at Christ Global Embassy with Pastors Sam and Jane Kakete. I stayed with a German missionary called Stephie in her bed and breakfast – a very nice home, especially by Ugandan standards.



We held 3 nights of revival meetings where I taught about the love of God and our value to Him. We had 2 nights of marriage training for the adults where many tough questions were asked and Scriptural principles were taught. On Saturday we had baptisms at a local swimming pool. On Sunday I preached the sermon, led communion and prayed over the people during a time of impartation. God showed up in power and many people were touched by Him. We also dedicated the land to God and set up the flagpole with their new Christ Global Embassy flag and the declaration “Jesus is Lord” on the pole.

On Sunday afternoon, we did an evangelistic outreach at the Soccer field during half-time of a game. During the week we also visited a hospital and prayed over women in labor and recovering from delivery. We had the opportunity to pray over a baby from a Muslim family in Christ’s name!



We saw several people get healed and delivered during the week. One man was healed from terrible stomach pains. An elderly woman came for prayer several times. She wanted to be able to read her Bible. On Sunday, she testified she could now read her Bible! Praise God!

This trip was really the beginning of Anna Ministry. This was the first time I was the speaker and one leading the training and praying. After returning home, I have been in a contemplative place. I now understand better the calling God has on my life. I am a little scared, a lot excited and looking to God for the provision and opportunity. As invitations are coming from various places in the world, please continue to pray for wisdom for me and for provision to meet the calling.



Again, I thank all of you who have prayed for me, given donations and spoken encouragement. I couldn't have done it without you. Probably the greatest miracle was my health. I was completely healthy the whole trip and since I have returned as well. I give the glory to God for all He did on this trip!
