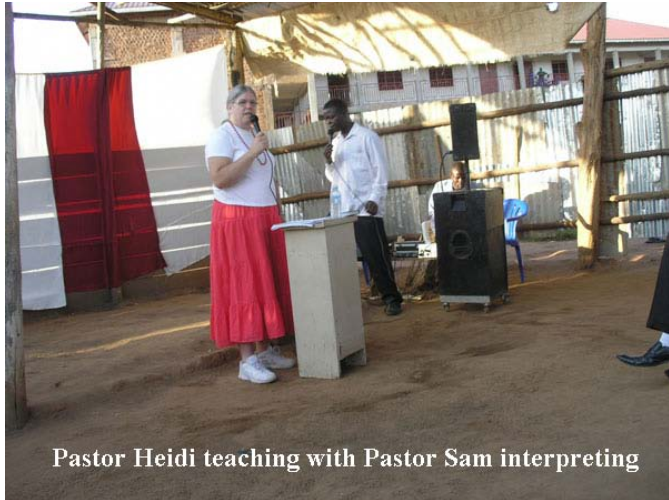


## Uganda 2010

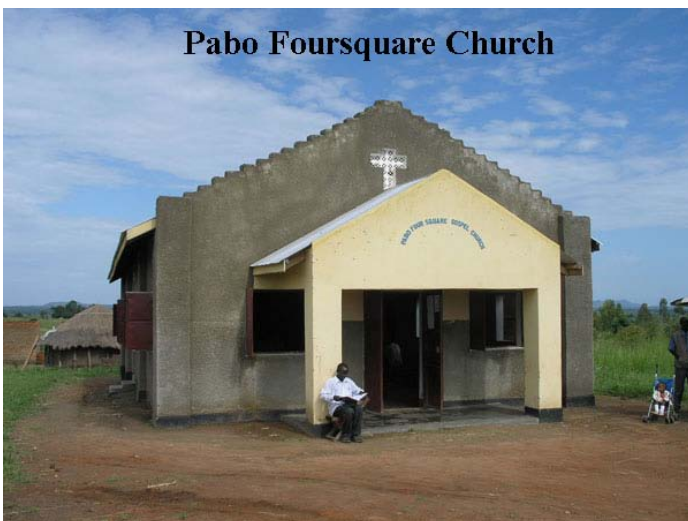
I left the USA on July 29<sup>th</sup> and arrived in Kampala, Uganda, on July 30<sup>th</sup> in the evening. The first day was spent getting purified water, exchanging money and resting up from the flights. Sunday morning I preached at Christ Global Embassy. Then the first pastors and leader's conference began Sunday evening and continued through Tuesday evening when we had a women's meeting.

Wednesday morning we headed north 6.5 hours on good road to Gulu Town. Thursday morning we traveled 1.5 hours on a bumpy dirt and gravel road to Pabo Foursquare Church. We had 2 days of meetings, returning to Gulu Town at night (the region is still a potentially dangerous place). I taught on "Two Important Questions": "Who is God?" and "What does He expect from me?" We talked about the names of God, the names of Jesus, the role of the Holy Spirit and Christian do's and don'ts. Pastor Sam taught on evangelism. God showed up in power as we prayed to release the Baptism of the Holy Spirit and healing anointing.

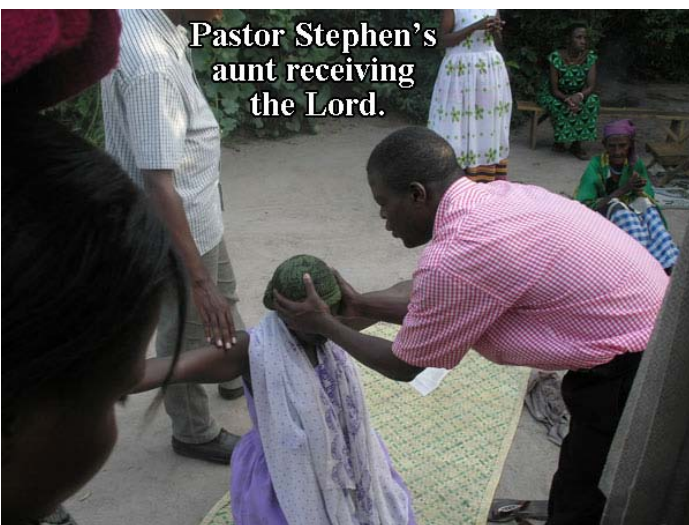
Sunday morning we traveled 2 hrs south to Kigumba Foursquare Church. I preached the Sunday sermon. Two people were saved. Sunday evening we began the conference. Again God showed up in power, touching the leadership. We consecrated the land where their church will be.

They had unusual demon attacks against their home. They were beginning a church. As we were preparing to leave, Steven's aunt, who had been very resistant to the Gospel, got saved!
